Responsibilities and Duties

The Primary Role of the Networking and Security Officer:

- 1. Installing computer security software, conducting regular security audits, preparing security status reports, educating TDB users on computer security, creating security documentation for users, assisting in disaster recovery and gathering evidence regarding cybercrimes and updating security policies;
- 2. Monitor computer networks and other security system for security threats or unauthorized users and prepare methods to minimise or eliminate such threats;
- 3. Developing and testing software deployment tools, firewalls and intrusion detection systems.
- 4. Monitor use of data files and regulate access to safeguard information in computer files.
- 5. Taking physical and software preventative measures to protect the underlying networking infrastructure from unauthorized access, misuse, malfunction, modification, destruction, or improper disclosure, thereby creating a secure platform for computers, users.
